**CRITICAL INFASTRUCTURE – Randy Clayton, SLED** –Mr. Clayton went into an overview of his job and how it relates to Hazard Planning and the LEPC. In summation, Mr. Clayton Manages the South Carolina Critical Infrastructure Protection Program for the SC Office of Homeland Security in support of the Senior Security Advisor to the Governor. In addition he does the following: conducts on site risk and vulnerability assessments of public and private sector critical assets across the state, provides detailed analysis of risks, vulnerabilities, interdependencies and consequence of loss of SC critical infrastructure, evaluates and recommends adoption of new or enhanced approaches to mitigate risk of key assets using available resources. In addition to all of this , he is also the primary point of contact with the U.S. Department of Homeland Security Protective Security Advisor for South Carolina, State Agencies and local officials in matters regarding South Carolina's Critical Infrastructure Protection Program.
